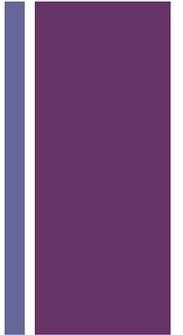


Feedback from SHIFT workshop

- *“... useful to break the ice among participants and get to know each other a little bit before starting working together.. it would be nice to have more.”*

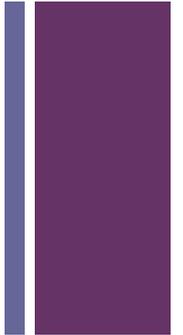


Presentations

+ Balance



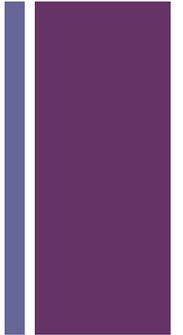
- One week is a short time but arguments have been dealt with in a comprehensive manner. I hope to be able to attend in-depth meetings

+ How productive?




- I understood the figure of the cultural mediator

- The perspectives from the different countries and mediation fields was very useful and interesting.

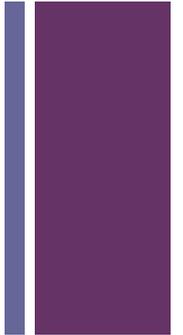


Best aspects ...

- Having time to focus on intercultural meditation and learning from other countries

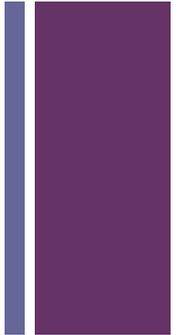

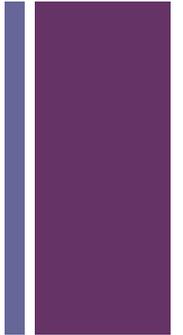
- I really enjoyed the visit at Casa the Caridad and the children explaining mediation in Spanish Schools.

+ Worst aspects

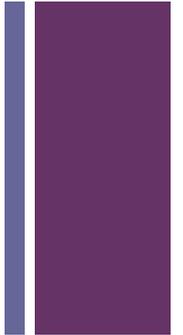


- The lack of involvement in the topic from some participants

+ Worst aspects continued

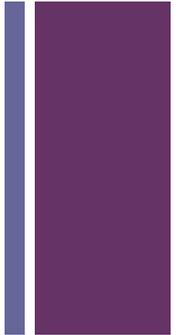
- The time-keeping. many participants did not arrive on time...Sometimes using 3 different languages and the need to translate make the flow a bit slower

+ Improvements



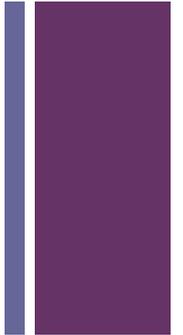
- Include some direct evidence from Roma or migrants [in workshop]

- Clearer focus on the expectations of the presentations - some were more relevant than others. More interactive activities



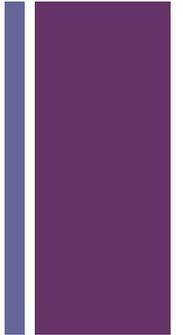
+ Improvements contd

- It could be improved inviting people from other countries in order to get more info about the topics treated

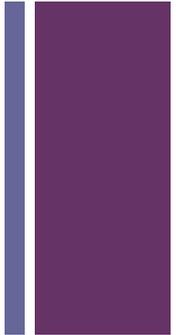
+ Change the way you work?

- Yes. Will do more training in mediation





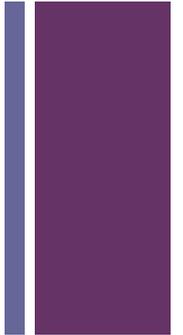
Change the way you work contd?

- Help at the other association for mediation



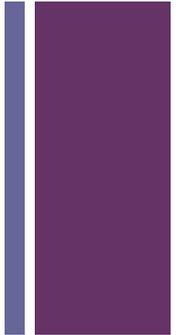
Change the way you work contd?

- To think without bounds. Using some Evaluation methodologies in training course, more simple and engaging

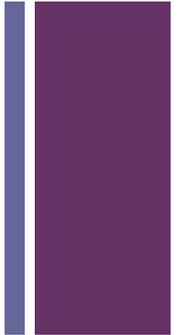


Conclusions for the future...?
